CONTACT YOUR PEDIATRICIAN



Your pediatrician may be able to refer you for a speech/language evaluation that is covered by your insurance, along with any necessary providers such as audiology or ENT.

CONNECT WITH A LOCAL SLP

You can also seek out private services with a local SLP, typically private pay or out-of-pocket cost. Contact Allie to determine if an evaluation, therapy, or virtual enrichment group is the right fit for you and your family.

CHECK YOUR EARLY INTERVENTION AGENCY OR SCHOOL DISTRICT

Your local Early Intervention agency (under 3 years) or school district (over 3 years) offers free or low-cost services. Call them to start the assessment process.
